



### **Theodore A. Stern, MD**

Dr. Stern is the Interim Director of the Center for Faculty Development at Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH), Director of the Office for Clinical Careers (OCC), the Chief Emeritus of the Avery D. Weisman, MD Psychiatry Consultation Service, as well as the Director of the Thomas P. Hackett Center for Scholarship in Psychosomatic Medicine at the MGH. Dr. Stern is the Ned H. Cassem Professor of Psychiatry in the field of Psychosomatic Medicine/Consultation at Harvard Medical School (HMS). He has focused his efforts at the interface of medicine and psychiatry, as a clinician, clinical researcher, and a teacher. Dr. Stern has mentored scores at the MGH and authored or co-authored more than 450 peer-reviewed journal articles and book chapters, as well as authored or edited 30 books. In addition, Dr. Stern is the Editor-in-Chief of *Psychosomatics*. On multiple occasions, he has won the coveted "Best Teacher Award" from graduating residents at the MGH/McLean Hospital Psychiatric Residency Training Program, he has garnered the MGH Department of Psychiatry's Award for Exceptional Mentorship in a Clinical Realm, and he has received the Society of Liaison Psychiatry's Lifetime Achievement Award, and the Thomas P. Hackett Award from the Academy of Psychosomatic Medicine (its highest honor).
